
The Face

- forehead
- cheek(s)
- ear(s)
- mouth
- hair
- eye(s)
- nose
- chin


Upper body



Labels for Upper body:


- chest
- thumb
- hand
- abdomen
- neck
- shoulder
- upper arm
- elbow
- forearm
- finger(s)

Lower body



Labels for Lower body:

- leg
- ankle
- hip
- thigh
- knee
- shin (front)
- calf (back)
- foot / feet



Grammar review

Plural nouns

Regular plurals:

Add 's' - *theatre/theatres, bed/beds, nurse/nurses, test/ tests, boy/boys* except when:

- the word ends in 's', 'sh', 'ch', 'x', 'z' - add 'es' - *box/boxes*
- the word ends in consonant + 'y' - change 'y' to 'i' and add 'es' - *baby/babies, tummy/tummies*
- the word ends in vowel + y - add 's' - *boy/boys, pay/pays*

Countable & Uncountable (Mass) Nouns

Countable nouns have a plural form and use a plural verb.

The beds have clean sheets.

Our nurses are highly trained.

Uncountable nouns do not have a plural form and use a singular verb.

Their urine smells strange.

Accurate information is important.




Range of motion (ROM)

Tilt your head back / forward



Rotate your arm / foot/wrist



Lift your arm /leg

Open or close your mouth



Point your toes

Pinch fingers together



Turn your head to the left / right

Bend your knee / bend backwards /forward
